# **OBJECTIVES**

This meeting is part of the activities proposed in the TAILEXER seed funding project (2023-2025). The project's objectives included deepening knowledge on topics related to physical exercise and cardiovascular health. Fostering dialogue and synergies among young researchers within partner universities. One of the objectives of this final international meeting is to promote the dissemination of scientific and academic research conducted by early career researchers from the EUGREEN Alliance.

#### PARTICIPANTS

Open to early career researchers (who got their PhD 8 years ago or less) who are currently pursuing a PhD or master's programme at any of the EU GREEN Alliance universities (Atlantic Technological University (Ireland), Högskolan i Gävle (Sweden), Otto-von-Guericke-Universität Magdeburg (Germany), Universidad de Extremadura (Spain), Universidade de Évora (Portugal), Università di Parma (Italy), Universitatea din Oradea (Romania), Université d'Angers (France), Uniwersytet Przyrodniczy we Wrocławiu (Poland)) may participate as speakers or attendees.

Early career researchers from EU GREEN Alliance universities may participate in the inperson sessions, although every university will be responsible for covering their costs.

Each participant may appear as the author of one individual presentation or up to two co-authored presentations. In all cases, they must participate in the presentation of any work in which they are listed as author or co-author to receive certification of participation. All participants will receive a certificate of attendance and participation, provided they present their work.

#### FORMAT

Presenters will use PowerPoint format presentations of their topics in person (no online option is available) which they have developed or are currently developing. The presentations will be followed by a question and answers session. This will help strengthen the university-business-society relationship and promote greater social engagement.

Presentation format - Presentation in person (8 minutes) / Q&A: 4 minutes

# ΤΟΡΙΟ

The meeting will focus on the topic on physical exercise and cardiovascular health. However, given that it is a multidisciplinary meeting, research from all perspectives is welcome including arts and humanities, sciences, health sciences, social and legal sciences, computer sciences, engineering.

Research topics should correspond to each researcher's current work, either individually or as part of their research group.
