


- April 16th 10-11a.m CET: Information session on MSCA Doctoral Networks. The
  MSCA Doctoral Networks are part of the Horizon Europe Funding Program and offer
  the opportunity to establish European networks for the innovative training of
  doctoral students. In addition to their own research project, doctoral students
  receive special trainings that will be useful for their future careers. The programme
  offers funding for up to 15 doctoral candidates for 3 years in each project. In
  addition to information on the programme and the application process, a successful
  applicant will also report on his experiences. Click here to join the webinar
- April 17th, noon to 1.30pm CET "Presentation of MSCA Postdoctoral fellowship call and opportunities for application within EU GREEN": The call is for research projects between an experienced researcher, who takes the role of a supervisor, and a postdoctoral fellow. 

#### CALLS

- Researcher mobility program: deadline 02nd of May 2024. This call provides funding up to 2000€ for mobilities within the EU GREEN alliance. Click here to access the complete bill of specification.
- **Call for supervision of theses.** Through the French National Agency for Research, the University of Angers has secured extra funding for theses in cosupervision with EU GREEN partners. Deadline May 6th. <u>Click here for the full bill of specifications.</u>
- WP2 Education has launched a call for the design of new joint degree programme. EU GREEN joint degree programmes are educational programmes at any level (bachelor, masters or PhD) that are jointly designed and organised by at least 3 partners, which upon successful completion are certified with either one joint degree or multiple degrees. These programmes should be constructed on the following pillars: research expertise at the Alliance level (anchored on the Research Clusters), promote sustainability through alignment with the EU GREEN graduate attributes framework and educational principles.

The funding offered depends on the number of participating universities and ranges from 17 800€ to 30 000€.

# MEET A RESEARCHER



Beatriz Ledesma is a researcher at the Applied Physics Department of the University of Extremadura (Spain) and member of research group for the comprehensive use of biomass waste and renewable energy. Currently, she works in the use of biomass waste as fuel or as activated carbon precursor, by means of different thermal processes (hydrothermal carbonization, gasification, pyrolysis...), as well as the application of carbon porous materials in adsorption processes both in liquid and gas phases. The research work is complemented with teaching tasks through the direction of final degree projects, seminars or laboratory practices, participation in teaching innovation groups and numerous teacher training courses. She has interests in ethical competencies, project-based learning, development cooperation and education for sustainable development.
