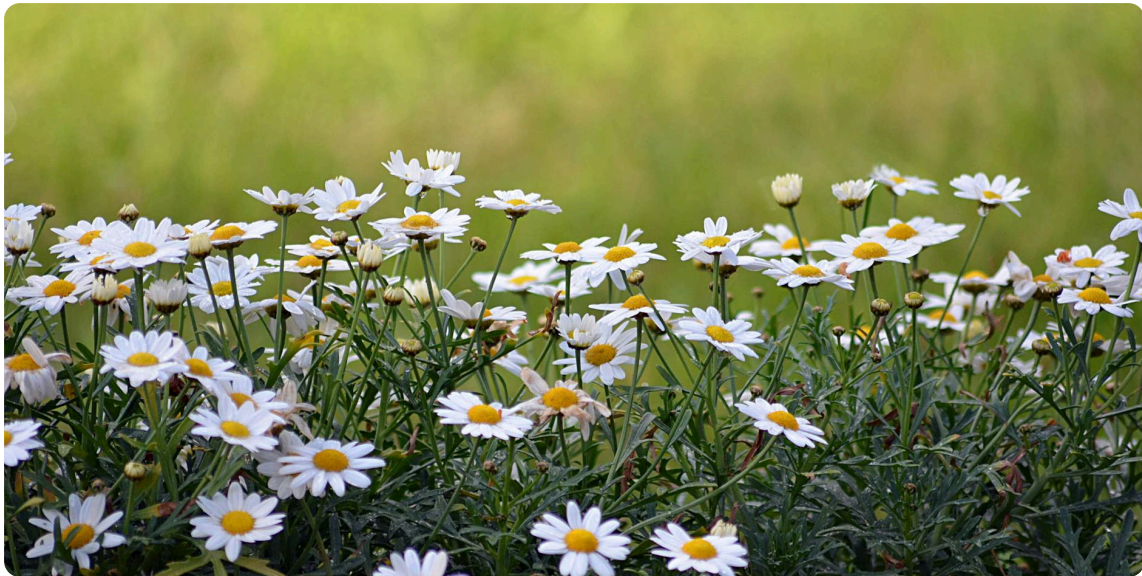

Teaching opportunities are published on a rolling basis throughout the 2025/2026 academic year, with expressions of interest accepted until 30 September 2026.

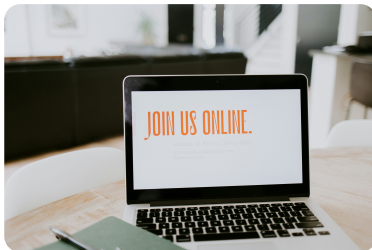

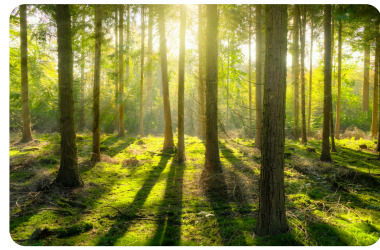

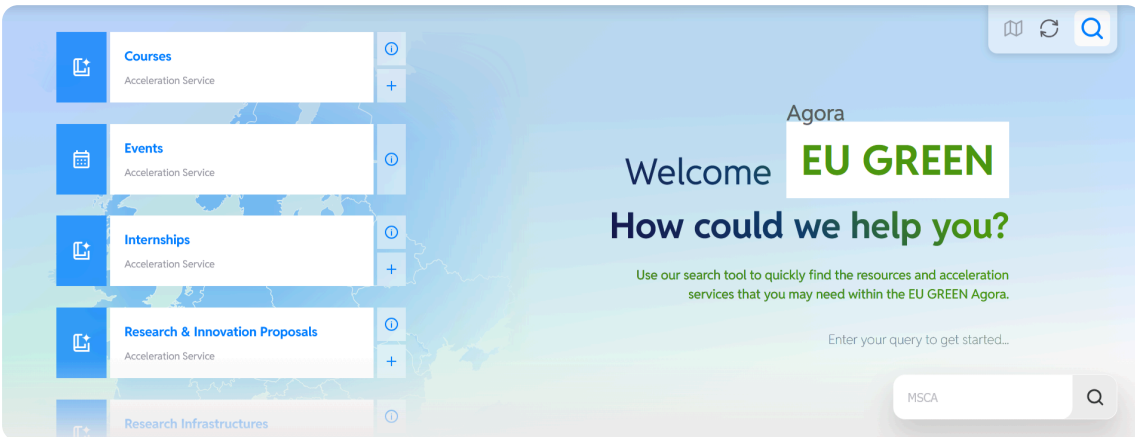

What's New on Agora?

Our Greenwork platform is going live soon!

Four training sessions will take place over the next few weeks to show our teams how to navigate the platform and upload different sets of data. These sessions will be structured around EU GREEN's main thematic hubs: **Education, Engagement, Mobility, and Research & Innovation**.

What does this mean for researchers?

Data collection is currently underway to build two new tools which may be of particular interest to researchers: a **Research Infrastructure Catalogue**, showcasing the equipment available within the Alliance, and a **Researchers' Directory**, listing researchers and their areas of expertise to facilitate networking and matchmaking.

The Research Infrastructure Catalogue is expected to be released **mid-2026**, followed by the Researchers' Directory in **late 2026**. You will be notified as soon as these tools become available.
