

### **FEEDBACK**

9. Did you have enough time for informal exchanges? (0 point)

#### **INFORMAL TIMES FEEDBACK**

- General satisfaction
- Good indications on how to come
  Some people felt they don't know the city enough even after the guided tour
- Organization at the restaurant not optimal
- The first night's gluten free options were too limited (raw vegetables only)
- Some felt the guided tour wasn't informative enough
- Not enough researchers from every university (none from OVGU)

#### FEEDBACK ON FORMAL TIMES

- General satisfaction
  - Great opportunity for networking
  - Meeting in person fastened the connections
  - Most demands were targeted towards more precise/concrete work and less "passive" times
  - o The Research Week was too short to draft a proposal for seed funding
- Clusters
  - Some people, including cluster leaders, are too focused on their own research and not on the collective work of the cluster
  - o The structure isn't defined well enough as of know which leads to a vertical approach
  - In cluster 5, some felt that the focus is too much on formal education as some researchers also work on informal education
  - In some cluster, including cluster 6, some people feel that their projects are ignored to the benefits of others
  - An encouragment to keep up with the online meetings is needed
  - Some expected more concrete next steps as 23-24 academic year will be crucial for demonstrating the concrete initiatives
- There was no allotted time slot to look at the posters and interact around them
- Maybe use a color code to identify clusters and/or institutions
- Make posters that are more representative of the institution
- More time with colleagues would be useful
- Workshops
  - More repetition of the workshops to allow people to attend more of them
  - Somes workshops could have been less general

#### **WEBSITE FEEDBACK**

- Include pictures of participants
- Make a longer description of the researchers
- More focus on the work areas of the researchers and their prospective fields
- Make a digital twin of the alliance
- Should include a work-in-progress page for the clusters
- Add the matchmaking functionality to the website
- A whiteboard page to express interest for cross-cluster works
- Give access to all the presentations

#### ORGANIZATION FEEDBACK

- Service could be more environmentally-friendly (less non -reusable packaging)
- The audio in the main room wasn't good
- Lack of AC (especially in the hotel + Galerie)
- Wifi issues on the phone
- Map of all the different meeting places\* (nb: this was available on the website, so more communication is needed)
